Triangular Chevron Shawl

(Revised by Bonnie Klatt from a pattern by Mary Ann Olson. July 2007)

Approximate size: 64" wide x 37" long at point. Continue until you run out of yarn or the shawl is the desired size.

Yarn: Any worsted weight yarn in any fiber. Wool is nice, but so is Lion Brand Cotton. Select yarn and color that catches your eye. You will need approximately 550-600 yards.

Needles: Experiment with US size 10.5, or any size that achieves the look you desire.

Instructions:

Cast on 2 stitches.

Row 1: K1, YO, Knit to end of row.

Repeat Row 1 until there are 12 stitches.

Next row: K1, YO, K3, K2tog, YO, place stitch marker on needle, Knit to end of row.

Note: **Please** read through all the instructions for the Pattern row before starting the row.

Pattern row: K1, YO, *K3, K2tog, YO*, repeat the stitch steps between the *'s evenly up to the marker. If less than 5 stitches remain before the marker, such that you cannot perform the *complete* sequence (K3, K2tog, YO) then simply knit those stitches. Slip the marker to the right hand needle, and knit to the end of the row.

Repeat Pattern row until you have reached the desired length at the point before adding the top border. Make sure that you have an uneven number of stitches on your needle.

Top Border

Row 1: K1, YO, K3, *K2tog, YO*. Repeat between *'s across until 7 stitches remain. Knit to end of row.

Row 2: K1, YO, Knit to end of row. Make sure you still have an uneven number of stitches. Repeat Row 2 five more times (i.e. rows 3-7).

Row 8: K1, YO, *K2tog, YO*. Repeat between *'s across, ending with K1.

Row 9: K1, YO, Knit to end of row. Repeat Row 9 three to five more times.

Bind off all stitches in knitting. Weave in ends.
